# BUSINESS GROWTH PROGRAM



#### **Program Description**

The Business Growth Program provides support for the following:

- Development and Commercialization for research and development (R&D) in Newfoundland and Labrador to enhance the capacity to overcome technical challenges and reduce financial risk; enable quick development of new or improved products, services and processes; or build collaborative R&D partnerships with industry, educational institutions and research facilities.
- Knowledge and Technical Assistance
   for fundamental business skills and access
   to expertise to increase competitiveness by
   enhancing critical employee skills; or acquiring
   external technical and advisory services.

- Productivity Improvement
   and Innovation for incremental firm level technology investments or innovative
   enhancements for continuous improvement
   and enterprise efficiency through process
   innovation; technology transfer; adoption of
   digitalization technologies for critical business
   processes; and support for the establishment
   of Intellectual Property Rights through patent
   searches and certification registration.
- Growth and Internationalization for increased market development and expansion, international trade activity, and accelerated growth via support for market research, market readiness; market development; marketing plans; product and service demonstrations; participation in trade missions; pitch opportunities; and pursuit of international joint ventures.



## Available Support with Financial Assistance

The Business Growth Program normally provides non-repayable contributions up to 50 per cent of eligible costs to a maximum of \$200,000 over 24 months (\$100,000 per year) per project, per company. Development and Commercialization projects, however, may be considered to a higher maximum normally up to \$750,000 over multiple years at varying amounts per year.

### **Eligible Applicants**

Eligible applicants must be businesses that are either:

- Growth-focused, innovative firms including sole proprietors, partnerships or corporations operating within Newfoundland and Labrador that demonstrate commercial viability; or
- Co-operatives or non-profit organizations operating within Newfoundland and Labrador that demonstrate an ability to generate commercial revenue or are pursuing international trade or economic development opportunities.

To qualify for assistance, eligible applicants must demonstrate:

- Ability to undertake the work identified in the project proposal;
- Ability to access the financial capital required to complete the project; and
- Good standing with the Government of Newfoundland and Labrador.
